


India Talent Shortage Over Time


Overcoming Talent Shortages

70% of employers plan to offer more flexibility in when or where to work as talent scarcity grows.



Cross-Border Teams Bridging Talent Gaps As hiring demand continues despite growing talent scarcity, 52% of employers are

willing to hire internationally, although 9% are not planning to accelerate this.



Nearly 4 in 5 employers globally report difficulty filling open roles with the biggest impacts being felt in Taiwan, Germany, and Hong Kong.
